CALLING ALL RECREATION PROJECTS

April is the only time of year that the following grant opportunities are available and specifically targeted at recreation projects. Please contact Shannon at District III for details and assistance.

Recreational Trails Program (RTP)

Applications due April 4, 2025

RTP is a program to help provide and maintain recreational trails for both motorized and non-motorized trail use. The program provides up to 80% reimbursement funds for all kinds of recreational trails including, but not limited to: pedestrian use, biking, in-line skating, equestrian use, cross-country skiing, off road motorcycles, OHV and UTV riding, four wheeling, and snowmobiling.

Land & Water Conservation Fund (LWCF)

Applications due April 25, 2025

LWCF is a program to help provide outdoor recreation facilities. The program provides up to 50% reimbursement funds for acquisition and development of outdoor recreation projects. Eligible applicants include city, county, township & tribal governments. Some eligible projects may include, but are not limited to: playgrounds, ballfields, sport and play fields, picnic facilities, pools, ice rinks, golf courses, amphitheaters, winter sports facilities, visitor information facilities and land acquisitions.
