Do you have a Water, Sewer or Storm Sewer Project?

There are two primary funding options for these projects; DANR State Revolving Fund (SRF) and USDA Rural Development Water and Environmental programs. DANR has quarterly applications due Jan 1, April 1, July 1 and October 1 whereas USDA-RD has an open funding cycle. When considering a project contact District III early so we can assist in coordinating your project in regards to application timing, submission and documentation requirements. Here are a few steps to consider prior to moving forward:

Step 1 - Contact District IIII staff for assistance

Step 2 - Work with District III and an engineering firm to define the project scope and costs

Step 3 - District III prepares a State Water Plan Application to be eligible for DANR funding

Step 4 – District III drafts funding applications
