DISASTER FUNDS STILL AVAILABLE

USDA Rural Development still has approximately **\$400,000** in **Community Facilities** disaster funds available for the FEMA-4807-DR disaster declaration in 2024 resulting from severe storms, straight line winds and flooding. The incident period was June 16, 2024 – July 8, 2024. If you have damage as a result of these incidents, it may be eligible for coverage. Lyman and Jerauld Counties are **not** eligible.
