## Governor’s House Changes: New Income Limits

Effective May 8, 2026, the new income limits for the Governor’s House Program are as follows:

Households of 2 or less	\$72,380
Households of 3 or more	\$82,720



Additionally, Governor’s Houses purchased for rental must be occupied by tenants making 60% or less of the Statewide Median Income. For 2026 that amount will be \$62,400.

## FEMA Assistance to Firefighters Grants

FY2025 Fire Grants Funding Notices Released – application period **opens Tuesday, May 19<sup>th</sup>** and **closes Monday, June 22<sup>nd</sup> at 4 P.M. CST**. The primary goal of the Assistance to Firefighters Grant (AFG) is to meet the firefighting and emergency response needs of the fire departments and non-affiliated emergency medical service organizations. Since 2001, AFG has helped firefighters and other first responders obtain critically needed equipment, protective gear, emergency vehicles, training and other resources necessary for protecting the public and emergency personnel from fires and related hazards. In the past 2 years, SD was awarded 9 grants; four in FY2024 and five in FY2023.
