Solid Waste Management Program (SWMP)

Funding Opportunity

This program provides funding for solid waste disposal, recycling and waste tire projects. The Board of Water & Natural Resources is authorized to provide funding in the form of a grant, loan, or combination of both to qualifying applicants. Eligible applicants include individuals, partnerships, llc's, corporations, counties, cooperatives, municipalities, regional or state-wide planning agencies, federally recognized Indian tribes, or special purpose districts that have the authority to construct or operate solid waste, waste tire or recycling facilities. **Applications must be postmarked or received at the department, on or before the first day of January, April, July, or October.** A grantee must provide a minimum 20% share of the total proposal cost.
